The 17th NEAS Forum was held from the 27th June to 29th June 2018, Hangzhou, China, which was hosted by SAC and CAS. The 17th NEAS Forum was attended by 122 experts from public and private sectors of China (62 participants), Korea (33 participants), and Japan (27 participants).

1. Opening

The Heads of Delegation from governments of China (Dr. CHEN Hongjun, SAC), Japan (Mr. SATO Fumikazu, JISC) and Korea (Dr. KANG Byung-goo, KATS), as well as the local government representative, Mr. LI Qiangyu, addressed the opening remarks by reaffirming their support for the successful 17th NEAS Forum to strengthen the trilateral cooperation amongst China, Japan, and Korea. Participants reconfirmed the importance of collaboration in the NEAS Forum to facilitate international standardization activities as stated in the “Joint Declaration for Peace and Cooperation in Northeast Asia” adopted at the Trilateral Summit in November, 2015.

2. Country Updates

SAC (Mr. TAO Liang), JISC (Mr. MATSUMOTO Mitsuo) and KATS (Dr. CHUNG Geewon) gave their respective presentations to share information on their recent important standardization policies and activities. ISO REI (Regional Engagement Initiative) Director (Mr. GOH Adrian) gave presentation on ISO's initiatives on regional engagement.

3. Ongoing Cooperative Items

CAS (Ms. XIA Weijia), JSA (Ms. SUZUKI Takako) and KSA (Ms. LEE Jooran) presented ongoing cooperative items led by each country to review the progress of cooperative items since the last meeting. After presentations and interactive discussion, the 17th NEAS Forum agreed to continue close cooperation on thirty items (Annex 1). The country indicated in the parenthesis is the proposing or responsible country, and the country shall present a status report on each item in the plenary meeting of the 18th NEAS Forum in 2019.

The Secretariats of the three countries shall identify, if not confirmed yet, and update contact information for the ongoing cooperative items. Based on the results of Study Group meeting held on 27th June, 2018, the Secretariats will review the ongoing cooperative items and Working Groups activities to identify non-active ones, which will be discussed to be disbanded or standby at the next NEAS Forum.

4. Report from the CJK-SITE

The Chinese Head of Delegation of the CJK-SITE, Ms. WANG Cong, summarized the recent activities of the CJK-SITE. The NEAS Forum noted that CJK-SITE plenary meeting was held in parallel with the NEAS Forum.

5. Report on Outcomes of last 16 Years of NEAS Forum

Entrusted by the three countries, SAC (Ms. FAN Chunmei) gave a report on the progress and outcomes made during the last 16 years of the Forum, recognizing the important role played by NEAS Forum in the standardization cooperation. Further cooperation and achievements are expected.

6. New Cooperative Item Proposals

18 new cooperative item proposals were presented (Annex 2), and the NEAS Forum will adopt the cooperative items on the results of voting. The three Secretariats shall submit the voting as well as the detailed contact information to the proposers of new cooperative item proposals by 31st July, 2018 to the Secretariat of the 17th NEAS Forum (China). The result of voting will be reported to the three Secretariats accordingly.

7. Study Group meeting

SG discussed the efficient management of Working Groups.

NEAS Forum appreciated the Japanese proposal on the procedure of WG operation, asked three countries to review the proposal and submit their comments to Japan by 31st July, 2018, and asked Japan to submit the revised proposal to the three Secretariats by 31st August, 2018.

8. WG Reports

Five WG meetings were held as a part of the 17th NEAS Forum and detailed report will be sent to the Secretariat of 17th NEAS Forum by 31st July, 2018. These WGs are:

WG 1 - Freight container,

WG 9 - Photocatalysis,

WG 11 - 3D digital,

WG 13 - Electrical scanning probe microscopy, and

WG 23 - The accessibility on Information & Communication Technology (ICT) for old persons and persons with disabilities.

The 17th NEAS Forum will note and adopt the five WGs reports accordingly.

The 17th NEAS Forum expressed its deepest appreciations to those WGs for their excellent activities.

9. Next Meeting

Japan made a proposal to host the 18th NEAS Forum in Takamatsu in the third week of July, 2019. Detailed schedule and venue will be announced later.

10. Adjournment

The NEAS Forum expressed its appreciations to SAC, CAS and city of Hangzhou for their hospitality and outstanding management of the Forum.
